



The present-day itinerary of the Via Francigena through Europe is being outlined and mapped. The Association has been joined by the City Council of **Canterbury**, where the zero stone is located, and by **Communauté Artoisienne**, which comprises the French municipalities of Estrée, Ligny-lès-Aire, Auchy-au-Bois, Amettes, Ferfay, Villiers-Hurionville and Burbure.

The historical route in **Italy** has been outlined and mapped thanks to EAVF, therefore the 140 Italian municipalities concerned with the itinerary have been identified.

Alternative routes are also being outlined and they will complete the general project.
